EMP 806: ENERGY MEDICINE INTERNSHIP

(3 credits)

Learning Objective:

The goal of the ENERGY MEDICINE INTERNSHIP is to permit the student to demonstrate professional competency in an Energy Medicine (EM) specialty. Real world experience can never be fully comprehended as a purely academic endeavor. Often professionally trained academics enter their chosen EM field after rigorous study and discover that the real-world aspect of the application of their knowledge is not suited for their professional goals or ideals. This internship gives the student the opportunity to investigate and examine the living aspects of their EM specialty in preparation for entering the career of an Energy Medicine practitioner.

Overview:

The range of specialties in Integrative and Holistic Health practice are arrayed across a broad spectrum of methods and disciplines. Examples of practice in which a student may choose to study with an internship include, but are not limited to Acupuncture, Acupressure, Apometrics, Aroma Therapies, Biofeedback, Color Diagnosis and Therapy, Electromagnetic Therapies, Herbology, Homeopathy, Kinesiology, Medical Intuition, Meditation & Stress Reduction, Music Therapy, Naturopathy, Psychometry, Reiki, Therapeutic Touch, Qigong, etc

Evaluation of locations and organizations in which student internships are appropriate is based on the standards of good practice that are particular to the special field. The professional societies or associations active in the field service as community arbiters of good practice and these standards are used to evaluate candidate internship sites. In addition, either active faculty with education and experience in the practice, or consulting faculty with education and experience in the practice, can serve as program and location evaluators of candidate internship sites.

Internship course faculty includes both the supervising faculty member and a field-site supervisor. The field-site supervisor will provide monthly student performance reports to the course supervising faculty member, and also provide a semester final assessment of student performance. Assessments by the on-site supervisor will provide evaluation of the student's integration and demonstration of professional competence, and accomplishment of program goals and objectives.

The student will provide to the course supervising faculty member an assessment of their own learning and performance, and also a scholarly paper investigating the tools, techniques, knowledge, and practices experienced during the specialty internship.

Course grading is determined by a final oral exam, the coursework papers, field-site supervisor and instructor assessment of integration and demonstration of professional competence during the Energy Medicine internship.

Communicating With Instructor

Telephone Contact: Students should arrange all telephone communications with the instructor by email beforehand. An initial phone contact to clarify course objectives and develop a schedule should be made prior to beginning the course. This contact should be scheduled within the first few weeks of commencement of the semester. After this, periodic telephone communication can be arranged with instructor. All telephone calls will be at student's expense.

Email Contact: Reflection on and questions about the coursework papers and field placement internship should be addressed via email monthly or as needed. Students are always encouraged to contact the instructor via email whenever a problem arises.

All lessons, coursework and papers must be copied to lessons@energymedineuniversity.org from both the student and professor.

Internet Threaded Discussion: There is also an on-going Internet threaded discussion among the students and faculty for the entire semester which creates a larger feedback mechanism of communication. Length of Internship:

Length of Energy Medicine internship practicum or professional practice is five (5) months or one (1) semester. Internship should accrue a minimum of 150 hours.

Audience:

Open to all students in the doctoral program.

Internship Placement:

It is the responsibility of the student to locate a professional organization for internship. The organization and placement of student must be approved by the faculty professor assigned to monitor the internship. Student must be under the guidance of an approved sponsor or mentor at the field internship site. A written provision of your internship signed by your on-site supervisor or mentor must be provided to your instructor before approval to commence the internship is granted.

Internship Insurance

The majority of programs at the University are conducted by 100% distance learning and do not require field or internship studies. However, this course in field studies was deemed essential to retain program completeness and integrity. Enrollment in this course is dependent upon the student obtaining prior comprehensive insurance coverage, which protects the student, the University, and any outside institution from liability claims.

Procedure

- 1. The student will submit an application to an appropriate insurance company in his or her region, requesting comprehensive insurance coverage for proposed field internship activities. This coverage must protect the student, the University, and any host institution in which internship studies are to be conducted.
- 2. Insurance is to be at the student's expense.
- 3. Documentation must be approved and signed by the student's Internship professor, and then a copy forwarded to the University office for approval with a copy added to the student file.

Coursework Papers and Instructor Examination:

- 1. Write a narrative paper describing how you communicate, define, and explain to both colleagues and lay-people/clients the practice of your Energy Medicine profession. Write the paper with an emphasis on: 1) describing your EM specialty and 2) explaining your EM specialty in reference to at least three other EM specialties. Include an annotated bibliography of books relevant to your EM specialty.
- 2. Using language from EM specialties and from Western/Allopathic Medicine create a list of analogous terminology. Provide definitions for each term on the list.
- 3. Determine which journals, periodicals, magazines, and so forth maintain and support your current understanding and continuing education in your EM specialty. Prepare a 10-page scholarly paper which describes the mission of each journal, periodical and magazine. Within the paper include a synopsis of articles or papers, or an excerpt from each which covers the relevance of the noted article or paper to your EM Specialty as well as to the overall field of EM.
- 4. Determine which conferences and organizations support your current understanding and continuing education in your EM specialty. Attend at least one conference or join at least one organization and prepare a 10-page descriptive paper which reports on the conference and/or the organization outlining how your continuing education in EM is supported by the organization or by attendance at the conference.
- 5. This is to be prepared at the end of your five month internship as the final paper: Write a 10-page self assessment of your EM Internship. Deliver this assessment paper to your field site supervisor or mentor and request that the supervisor or mentor make comments and email or postal mail the paper with his or her comments to your EMU internship faculty professor.
- 6. This is to be requested at the end of your five month internship: Ask your on-site supervisor or mentor to write an assessment of your internship. The assessment should include your overall performance and suggested directions for strengthening your professional performance in the EM profession. The assessment should also note your total internship hours. Ask your supervisor or mentor to directly postal mail or email the

assessment to your monitoring professor. See the evaluation letter to be handed to your internship supervisor within this syllabus. Print it and hand to your supervisor.

7. Final oral examination with instructor:

Please prepare a short comprehensive overview of your personal field study objectives and whether you estimate that you have accomplished those objectives. This oral communication will also include a few key questions that the instructor will ask you to respond to in regards to your internship practice.

8. Final Course Paper:

Using a current APA style manual write a 20 page scholarly paper describing your intuitive processes, impressions and personal critique of what you have learned and experienced. In the paper emphasize which tools, techniques, knowledge, practices, and so forth have been most efficacious in application of your Energy Medicine specialty during this Internship.

Time Line for Coursework Papers:

The length of this 3 credit course is five months in order to allow the student time to accrue 150 on-site internship hours. The papers should be completed in a timely manner according to your instructor's direction. A suggested timetable is to complete and submit to your instructor one of the five papers every month. This will give you ample time to both absorb your professional internship experience and as well, to develop the language of a professional Energy Medicine practitioner which can be communicated verbally and also delivered in written form to both colleagues and patients.

Research Texts:

It is recommended that the student research texts which are appropriate to their Energy Medicine specialty. A comprehensive, but not exhaustive, list is included at the end of this syllabus.

Grading:

Course grades are based on the following elements of a student's participation and accomplishment. Course grading determined by final oral exam, the coursework papers, field-site supervisor and instructor assessment of integration and demonstration of professional competency during the Energy Medicine internship. An evaluation letter for you to hand to your field-site supervisor is included within this syllabus.

In determining grades the following formula will be used:

Reading texts – 20% Email and Internet Discussions – 15% Course Papers or Project – 30% Final Oral Examination with Instructor – 20% Field Site Supervisor and Self-Assessment Papers – 20%

Using this technique, there will be 100 points assigned to the course. Final semester grades will be calculated as follows:

This course awards 3 semester credits.
